The grooup fears emigre housing will displace Palestinians. Groups in opposition included, Colorado Coalition for the Homeless, New Jewish Agenda, Sane/Freeze, American Arab Anti-discrimination Committee, Colorado Coalitiion for the Prevention of Nuclear War, Women's International League for Peace, Freedom, American Friends Service Committee, Colorado Muslim Society, Colorado campaign for Middle East Peace & Council of Churchs. 10-14-91, Det. Potter reported that New Jewish Agenda was recognized during An AIM protest on 10-12-91 (anti-Columbus Day parade), for his support of the AIM movement. 7,22-92, Lakewood PD submitted a report on this date in regards to KKK railies in Colorado Springs and Aurora on 7-18-92 & 7-19-92. A report on counter demonstrators included representatives from American Friends Service Committee & Pledge of Resistance. 6-4-93, Det. Landin prepared a report on a demonstration at the State Capitol by Guatemaia Culture & Policy Project, Denver Justice & Peace Committee, with support from AIM (Security). The event was orgalized by Included was an extensive list of plates of participants. 6-23-93, A report was prepared about a demonstration this date at noon at ADL, protesting alleged domestic spying by ADL on other political groups. Speakers were from AFSC & AIM, A list of license plates & news articles was included. 10-10-94, The subject signed in support an open letter signed by American Indian Movement on their problems with Columbus celebrations/government. 10-28-99, On this date Det. Kennedy prepared a report on an Amnesty International rally held on 10-22-99. The subject was part of a group that met at Civic Center, then marched to City & County Bldg., and then on to the police building to protest police brutality. The event was peaceful with no problems. A list of participants was included. 11-23-99, Det. Kennedy prepared a report in regards to a demonstration held on 11-17-99 at the Federal Building by members of Ancient Forest Rescue, Rocky Mountain Peace & Justice and Vail Expansion Opponents, et al, to protest government actions against protesters in Vail fires, protesting forced grand jury testimony.
