**ORDER**



IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the District Attorney for the 19<sup>th</sup> Judicial District shall not initiate the prosecution of Thomas Mink under Colorado's Criminal Libel Statute, C.R.S. § 18-13-105, and the City of Greeley shall, forthwith, return to Plaintiffs the computer, and all contents thereof, seized following the search of Plaintiffs' home in Ault, Colorado.
