PERMANENT INJUNCTION

This matter having come before the Court on Plaintiffs' Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings, and this Court finding good cause existing therefore;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that a permanent injunction be issued in favor of Plaintiffs and against Defendants as follows:

- 1. On March 16, 2009, this Court entered its Order Pending Decision on Motion for Preliminary Injunction ("Interim Order") and required the Defendants to deliver to the custody of the Clerk of the Court all Materials at issue in this case.
- 2. "Materials" as used in the prior paragraph and through this Permanent Injunction include:
- a. All files seized from Amalia's Translation & Tax Services, and any copies (whether paper or electronic) of those files, including but not limited to, copies retained in evidence by the Sheriff's Office or the District Attorney or in the possession, custody or control of any agent of either the Sheriff or the District Attorney.

- b. All electronic media (including, but not limited to, computer disks, CDs, or hard drives) seized from Amalia's Translation & Tax Services, and any copies thereof.
- c. Any and all evidentiary or investigative material and the fruits thereof derived from the files seized from Amalia's Translation & Tax Services, including, without limitation, investigative reports, notes, witness interviews, employment records obtained from third party employers, the results of computer searches from electronic databases, computer files, and any other information or evidence, in whatever form, derived directly or indirectly from the tax files seized from Amalia's Translation & Tax Services.
- d. "Materials" shall not include any documents or files (paper or electronic) or the results thereof, relating to any individual who was charged with a criminal offense arising out of the search Operation Numbers Game as of 4:30 p.m. March 10, 2009.
- 3. On April 20, 2009, this Court entered its Order on Plaintiffs' Motion to (1) Proceed via Pseudonym, (2) for Class Certification and (3) for Preliminary Injunction ("Preliminary Injunction") converting the Interim Order into a Preliminary Injunction.
- 4. Pursuant to the Interim Order and the Preliminary Injunction, the parties delivered all Materials at issue in this case to the Clerk of the Court. Such Materials are currently in the possession of the Clerk of the Court.
- 5. The Clerk of the Court is hereby ordered to destroy all Materials deposited with the Clerk pursuant to this Court's Interim Order and Preliminary Injunction.
- 6. The Defendants are prohibited from using or disseminating any information derived from the above-referenced Materials.
- 7. This Permanent Injunction is on-going and applies to all agents and employees of both Defendants: any later-discovered Materials in Defendants' possession, custody or control which could reasonably be covered by this injunction must immediately be destroyed by Defendants and no such Materials may be copied, preserved, disseminated or used in any way.
