**ORDER**

This matter is before the court *sua sponte* at the direction of the panel of judges assigned to hear oral argument in, and decide the merits of, this appeal. On January 24, 2025, the Supreme Court granted the petitions for writs of certiorari filed in *Ok. Charter School Board v. Drummond*, 24-394; and *St. Isadore v. Drummond*, 24-396, which seem to present questions related to those at issue in this appeal.

Within 10 days of the date of this order, the parties shall file simultaneous supplemental briefs addressing whether this matter should be abated, and the March 18,

2025 oral argument vacated, pending the Supreme Court's issuance of a decision in *Ok. Charter* and *St. Isadore*. The parties' simultaneous supplemental briefs may be no longer than 15 pages in a 13- or 14-point font, and while the briefs need not comply with the content requirements of Fed. R. App. P. 28(a), they should be organized in a manner that is helpful to the court. Hard copies need not be submitted.
