I've attached the capacity chart which shows that we have 76,800 total beds. 72,000 of them are usable (b)(5)

Space that will come online in the next few weeks. The total number of beds when fully operational will be (b)(7)(E).

- **Port Isabel Expansion (soft side)** in the Harlingen AOR (b)(7)(E) beds in December.
- **Diamondback Detention Center** in the Dallas AOR (Oklahoma) – (b)(7)(E) beds total with some availability in late December
- **Camp East Montana (Bliss)** in the El Paso AOR – the current capacity is (b)(7)(E). The facility could house up to (b)(7)(E) if the vendor can hire enough staff.
