NARRATIVE:

On 06/20/2024 at approximately 173 hours I was dispatched to an animal at large in the parking lot of the Silverthorne Recreation Center, located at 590 Rainbow Dr. in the Town of Silverthorne, Summit County, Colorado.

Upon arrival, I observed several people trying to catch a small "Husky/Chihuahua" mixed dog that appeared to be a puppy. I was able to catch the small dog, which had no collar and no identifying information, and transported the animal to the Summit County Animal Shelter where I placed the dog in a kennel and filled out the shelter after hours form.

On 06/21/24 at approximately 1500 hours, I was advised that the owner of the dog Carlos E. Tettamanti (DOB 1/23/78) was in the lobby of the Silverthorne Police Department to pick up a citation before he could pick up his dog at the shelter. I met with Mr. Tettamanti who stated this isn't the first time his dog has gotten out, which I verified with SPD cases 2023-669 and 2024-0164. I issued Mr. Tettamanti a citation for failing to control a pet animal T.O.S. 2-2-6 on citation # 68272 and informed Mr. Tettamanti that if he was contact information on the dog if the dog is caught be a member of the public or the police, we would much rather call him and return the dog rather than taking the dog to the shelter. Mr. Tettamanti was receptive to the information and stated he was going to order new collar and tags for his animals tonight.

You are before the Court because a peace officer for this City has charged you with a violation of the law.

YOU HAVE THE FOLLOWING RIGHTS:

1. To appear before a judge.
2. To be advised by the Court of the nature of the charges against you and the maximum penalty.
3. To be presumed innocent of the charges, and if you plead not guilty, the prosecution must prove you guilty beyond a reasonable doubt.
4. To bail and to be advised of the amount of bail that has been set by the Court.
5. To make no statement, but you may make a statement, at your choosing, knowing it may be used against you.
6. To be represented by counsel, and if indigent, the right to appointed counsel as applicable.
7. If you are not a citizen of the United States, you are advised that a conviction of the offense for which you are charged may have consequences of deportation, exclusion from admission to the United States or denial of naturalization pursuant to the laws of the United States. Consultation with an immigration attorney is advised before entering a plea.
8. To have a trial by jury if such right is granted by ordinance. Such demand must be made in writing within twenty-one (21) days of entering a not guilty plea and you must pay a twenty-five (\$25) jury fee unless the judge because of indigence waives the fee. If you fail to meet the above conditions, your trial shall be by the Court.
9. To compel the attendance of witnesses in your behalf by subpoenas, issued by the Court, without expense to you; to confront and cross examine the witnesses against you.
10. To testify or not testify in your own behalf. Your silence does not imply any wrongdoing on your part and cannot be used against you.
11. To appeal any judgement within thirty-five (35) days after the judgement is entered to the district and appellate courts of Colorado, however, if you plead guilty, you waive your right to appeal.
12. To a continuance of this arraignment, for good cause shown.

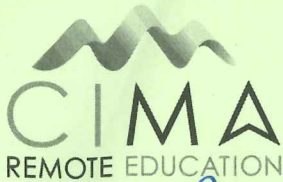

MOTION REGARDING DUE PROCESS VIOLATIONS AND LACK OF PROCEDURAL COMPLIANCE
BY THE MUNICIPAL COURT

COMES NOW the Defendant, Carlos Esteban Tettamanti, pro se, and moves this Honorable Court to recognize and address the due process violations that have occurred in this case due to the municipal court's failure to adhere to Colorado state laws and procedural guidelines. In support, Defendant states as follows:

I. Failure to Comply with Colorado State Laws on Warrant Procedures

1. The municipal court failed to follow the Colorado state laws and guidelines that govern how municipal courts should issue and serve warrants.
2. Specifically, Defendant was never properly notified of the court date or the issuance of the warrant in accordance with these laws.
3. The court's limited schedule and lack of any process to address or quash the warrant outside of the monthly meeting date effectively denied the Defendant the right to be heard in a timely manner.

II. Violation of Due Process Rights

1. By not providing any means for Defendant to address the warrant or appear before the court in a reasonable timeframe, the municipal court has violated the Defendant's due process rights under the Fourteenth Amendment of the U.S. Constitution and the Colorado Constitution.
2. The Defendant presents as evidence an email from the prosecuting attorney, acting as the DA, explicitly stating that there was no way to quash the warrant other than turning oneself in or avoiding law enforcement. See EXHIBIT A

III. Incurred Damages

Defendant respectfully is stating the damages caused from the execution of 2 wrongful arrest were solely caused by the fact that the Silverthorne Municipal Courts had failed to Comply with State laws regarding Service and violated Defendants Due Process Rights

1. Defendant was arrested while procuring a job in a restaurant located in Frisco CO, due to such arrest he was not able to show up and deliver client the installation he was contracted to deliver and customer kicked the defendant out of the job site for not delivering the job by the contracted date.
2. Defendant was arrested by Frisco Police and taken to the Summit County jail in Breckenridge Colorado. After Defendant was handcuffed, police proceeded to search him and took his insulin from him. When defendant was booked at the county jail, he reiterated to the authorities that he needed insulin intermediately but was not provided any. About 2 hours after the booking took place, authorities finally noticed that defendant had a serious issue and called an ambulance. Ambulance arrived and Defendant was rushed to Frisco to the local hospital. Defendant was placed in an intensive care unit and was accompanied by a police officer at all times since he was technically under arrest. Authorities allowed defendant to bond out without posting any money with the courts as they knew that they had not treated the defendant properly and had denied him proper medical care. Although the defendant is filling a different case at another jurisdiction, Defendant would have never been put in this position if the Silverthorne courts had followed due process as per Colorado Law. Defendant deems the Municipality to be the cause of these incurred damages.
3. On June 26th, 2025 Defendant sent an email to the clerk of the Municipal Courts inquiring if he had any outstanding warrants because he was in the process of obtaining a Motorcycle endorsement on his Drivers License and he feared that there could have been an outstanding warrant. SEE EXHIBIT B. The clerk of the Municipal courts replied stating that there were NO outstanding Municipal warrants but that there was an open case and stated that Defendant owed the court \$400. Clerk failed to notify Defendant that there was an upcoming court date that he needed to show up at, even after Defendant specifically inquired about the status of the case and made sure that there where no upcoming dates that he could possibly not show up and have to deal with another warrant.
4. On September XX, there was an noise complaint made against the Defendant at his residence. Defendant resolved the complaint matter but when police asked him to identify himself and ran his information through their system there was an arrest warrant which defendant had never been notified about, and proceeded to once again taking him into custody.
5. Defendant has suffered many damages due to this 2 wrongfull arrest and demands the court to grant him a monetary relief

III. Relief Requested


Defendant respectfully requests that this Court:

MOTION TO RECONSIDER OR VACATE ORDER DENYING DEFENDANT'S
"MOTION REGARDING DUE PROCESS VIOLATIONS AND LACK OF
PROCEDURAL COMPLIANCE"

COMES NOW the Defendant, **Carlos Esteban Tettamanti**, pro se, and respectfully moves this Honorable Court, pursuant to C.R.Crim.P. 33, C.M.C.R. 232, and the Court's inherent authority to correct or reconsider prior rulings, to reconsider or vacate its **Order dated September 30, 2025**, which denied Defendant's "Motion Regarding Due Process Violations and Lack of Procedural Compliance." **I. GROUNDS FOR RECONSIDERATION**

1. The Court's September 30 Order did not address the substantive due-process issues raised in Defendant's motion, including: (a) that Defendant was denied any opportunity to quash or contest the warrant prior to arrest; (b) that the municipal court's limited hearing schedule provided no meaningful access to judicial review; and (c) that the lack of notice and inability to be heard in a timely manner violated U.S. Const. amend. XIV and Colo. Const. art. II § 25.

2. The finding that Defendant "had actual notice" is unsupported by the record. On June 26, 2025, Defendant emailed the Municipal Court Clerk specifically asking whether any warrants or court dates were pending. He was informed there were none, despite a Show-Cause Order issued June 27, 2025. This misinformation prevented Defendant from appearing or curing the issue before the July 17, 2025 warrant issued.

3. The Court did not address "Exhibit A" email correspondence from the Town Prosecutor—stating there was no available procedure to quash the warrant other than surrendering or waiting until the next court date. Such a policy denies a meaningful opportunity to be heard. See *Mathews v. Eldridge*, 424 U.S. 319 (1976); *Goldberg v. Kelly*, 397 U.S. 254 (1970).

4. The Court's statement that it "will stay the warrant now that Defendant has contacted the Court" effectively acknowledges that prior notice and contact were lacking—supporting Defendant's claim that he was not afforded due process.

II. LEGAL AND PROCEDURAL ERRORS IN THE ORDER

5. The Order denied dismissal of the warrant and charges "for lack of cited authority," yet Defendant's motion relied on constitutional provisions and Colorado procedural law governing warrant issuance and notice. The absence of specific findings leaves the ruling unreviewable on appeal.

6. While the Court correctly found it lacked jurisdiction to award damages, that portion was ancillary; the primary relief—recognition and correction of due-process violations—is within

this Court's jurisdiction.

III. RELIEF REQUESTED

WHEREFORE, Defendant respectfully requests that the Court:

1. Acknowledge the due process violations that have occurred due to the municipal court's failure to provide proper procedural safeguards.
2. Vacate or reconsider its September 30, 2025 Order;
3. Issue specific findings of fact and conclusions of law addressing Defendant's due-process and notice arguments;
4. Quash or recall the outstanding warrant, or alternatively, convert it into a summons;
5. Refund any appearance-bond monies posted in relation to the warrant; and
6. Grant any further relief deemed just and proper to ensure compliance with the Colorado and United States Constitutions.
