Narrative Summary:

Narrative: The following information pertains to Intelligence Section files 5.9, dated 11-22-86 to 11-23-99, about the subject, Margaret Taniwaki. 11-22-86, it was reported that on this date, 'Radicals left their Marx on Colfax' article on people involved with the Radical Information Project (RIP) Bookstore. 2-21-87, Det. Buysse reported that on 2-20-87, a meeting took place at the Guadalupe Hall at 7:00 PM, sponsored by CASA, CHRICA, and included a list of speakers and vehicle registrations of attendees. 6-24-87, Det. Buysse reported that on 6-23-87, a meeting took place at Montview Presbyterian Church by the Coalition For Unity with Central America, protesting U.S. policy, Contra atrocities, with a list of groups and parties attending. 7-26-88, Det. Carter reported that he received information from a CI on financial support of MLN activities in New Mexico. 5-22-91, A report was prepared this date regarding an editorial which appeared in the Colorado Statesman, 5-10-91, signed by Taniwaki and et al, in regards to 'Police, civil leaders to blame for white supremacists fighting', signed organizations 'Making Waves' 6-4-93, Det. Landin prepared a report on a demonstration at the State Capitol by Guatemala Culture & Policy Project & Denver Justice & Peace Committee, with support from AIM (security). The event was organized by [redacted]. The report had an extensive list of license plates of participants & persons observed at the demonstration. 4-17-94, Det. Humphrey reported that Margaret Taniwaki was active in the Chinook Fund and Making Waves. She was passing out flyers by groups involved in speaking engagement of [redacted] Japanese American incarcerated during WWII, speaking against the U.S. Government policies. She is also on the Mayor's Asian Advisory Council. 5-4-94, report indicated that subject was one of six Coloradans to be honored for civii rights work. 10-10-94, A report was prepared regarding an open letter signed by the American Indian Movement on their problems with Columbus celebrations/government. Signed in support. 10-23-98, A report was prepared by Det. Pontarelli on groups and persons participating in a rally for 'police accountability' held 10-22-98 at Civic Center Park followed by a March to City & County Bldg. and to the Police Department with a list of 'demands' for police. 11-23-99, A report was prepared by Det. Kennedy in regards to a demonstration on 11-17-99, at the Federal Building by members of Ancient Forest Rescue, Rocky Mountain Peace & Justice and Vail Expansion Opponents, et al, to protest government actions against protesters in Vail fires, protesting forced grand jury testimony. Several people expressed their opinion against government. A list of participants was included.
